Addendum Issue Date: **October 28, 2011**

Purpose: The purpose of this Addendum is to make changes and provide clarification of the bid documents for the above referenced project dated October 2011. Bidders shall review the Addendum and incorporate any effects the Addendum may have in their bid price.

Acknowledgment: **Bidders must acknowledge receipt of any and all Addenda in the space provided on the bid form.** Failure to do so may result in rejection of the bid.

Note: All requirements of the bidding documents remain unchanged except as cited herein.

Part 1- Amendments to Bid Documents

- All trails are to be ten (10) feet wide, with the exception of Envirogrid, which only expands to a maximum width of nine (9) feet.
- Bidders are responsible for having proper certifications at the time of contract award. This includes a Georgia State Soil Erosion License. Under Georgia State Law for best management practices to prevent soil erosion, Contractor will be responsible for implementation of necessary erosion control measures to ensure protection of state waters and for prevention of soil from leaving the park property onto adjacent properties.
- Contractor will need to provide a portable restroom on site for the duration of the project.
- At time of project close-out, Contractor will be responsible for removal of all temporary facilities, equipment, forms, trash and any other foreign materials brought onto the site during construction.
- Soil, rock and any cleared vegetation will be stockpiled to remain on site at the Owner's direction.
